This is to inform you that on March 25, 2009 the enrolled actuary for the I.A.T.S.E. Local No. 3 Pension Plan (the "Plan") certified to the US Department of the Treasury, and also to the plan sponsor, that the Plan is in critical status for the plan year beginning January 1, 2009.

On April 16, 2009 the plan sponsor elected under the Worker, Retiree and Employer Recovery Act of 2008 §204(c)(1) to maintain for the 2009 plan year the 2008 plan year status where the Plan was not critical and not endangered. Federal law requires that you receive this notice.

Endangered / Critical status

Due to the magnitude of the unexpected investment losses in the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> quarters of 2008 the Plan would have been in endangered status for the 2009 plan year because it has future funding problems.

You will be notified of the Plan's status annually if the Plan is in endangered or critical status. The Board of Trustees is in the process of designing and adopting a plan to improve the Plan's funding status. The steps to improve the plan's funded situation may include increases in contributions and reductions in future benefit accruals as permitted by Federal law.
