#### **Qualifying Events**

Typhoon Mangkhut made landfall in CNMI on September 10, 2018, causing significant wind and water damage, as well as widespread power outages across the Commonwealth. Storm damage and rough waters are also limiting the remote islands' access to the deliveries of water and other consumable resources.



#### **Proposal Summary**

The Commonwealth of the North Mariana Islands (CNMI) Workforce Investment Agency submitted an application requesting \$2,762,345 in Disaster Recovery National Dislocated Worker Grant (DWG) funding. The purpose of the project is to create disaster relief employment for eligible individuals to assist with cleanup activities in response to Typhoon Mangkhut.



#### **Project Description**

This Federal declaration allows the Commonwealth to request DWG funding to assist with cleanup efforts in three island municipalities declared eligible for FEMA's Public Assistance Program: Rota, Saipan, and Tinian. The Commonwealth will use the funding to create approximately 75 disaster relief positions to assist with cleanup activities in each of these municipalities.



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
