Economic Transition Factors

During 2018, several employers located in the northeastern part of Ohio, were affected by trade-impacted layoffs. The employers affected are: Comprehensive Logistics and Source Providers, General Motors, LLC, Jamestown Industries, and Lordstown Seating Systems.



Proposal Summary

The State of Ohio, Department of Job and Family Services, submitted a funding request on August 7, 2018, to operate a DWG project serving approximately 337 of the 1,686 workers affected by trade-impacted layoffs. The DWG funding will primarily provide these workers access to critical supportive services not available through the TAA program, also enabling participants to stay in training through completion.



Proposed Outcome

This Dual Enrollment DWG project will provide the affected workers, who are all also certified as eligible for the TAA program, with access to the employment and training services not covered under the TAA program. Participants will be able to access a variety of WIOA sponsored services.



Sectors of Focus

The economic sectors of focus are in the advanced automotive manufacturing sector. It is expected that with both DWG and TAA employment and training services provided, these individuals will be able to secure new comparable employment.



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
