

## Hurricane Florence

GRANT NUMBER: DW-32747-19-60-A-45

Counties of Chesterfield, Darlington, Dillon, Florence, Georgetown, Horry, Marion, Marlboro, and Williamsburg.



On September 15, 2018, Hurricane Florence hit the shores of South Carolina, causing major damages to both residences, businesses, and roads. The storm was declared a major disaster by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), under South Carolina Hurricane Florence, DR-4394.



The South Carolina Department of Employment and Workforce submitted an application requesting \$500,000 in Disaster Recovery National Dislocated Worker Grant (DWG) funding. The funding will allow the state to begin the creation of disaster relief employment for approximately 25 eligible individuals to assist with cleanup efforts across nine counties affected by the hurricane.



# **Project Description**

The Employment and Training Administration approved DWG funding of \$500,000. The funding will allow the State to assist with cleanup efforts in nine counties declared eligible for FEMA's Public Assistance Program. In addition to cleanup efforts, the funding will also allow for the provision of humanitarian aid.
