Qualifying Events

On September 16, 2020, Hurricane Sally made landfall a few miles west of Pensacola, Florida as a Category 2 hurricane. FEMA issued the emergency declaration Florida Hurricane Sally on September 15, 2020.

Proposal Summary

The Florida Department of Economic Opportunity submitted an application to the Department on September 21, 2020, requesting \$5,000,000 in Disaster Recovery National Dislocated Worker Grant (DWG) funding. The purpose of the proposed project is to create disaster-relief employment for eligible individuals to assist with cleanup and recovery activities in response to Hurricane Sally.

Project Description

The DWG funding will assist with debris removal, cleanup and repair of properties damaged by the storm. Humanitarian assistance, such as staffing of shelters, assistance with food and supplies storage and distribution, assistance to individuals accessing disaster-recovery resources (including business owners), support to service agencies with a significant workload increase.
