Qualifying Events

Hurricane Dorian did not make landfall in Florida; however, the storm's passage along the coast resulted in extraordinary levels of storm surge and flooding along with wind gusts of 130 miles per hour. The Federal Emergency Management Agency issued declaration EM-3419 on August 30, 2019.



Proposal Summary

The Florida Department of Economic Opportunity submitted an application requesting \$3,000,000 to receive disaster DWG funding. The purpose of the proposed project is to create disaster-relief employment for eligible individuals to assist with cleanup and recovery efforts in response to damage incurred by Hurricane Dorian.



Project Description

The state proposes to use the requested DWG funds for cleanup activities in 4 counties, enrolling approximately 150 participants to address the cleanup and repair of damaged and destroyed structures, facilities and lands located within the disaster area.

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
