

## Hurricane Michael

Hurricane Michael made landfall in Florida on October 10, 2018, as a Category 4 Hurricane. The storm received an emergency disaster declaration from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) on October 9, 2018 under Florida Hurricane Michael (EM-3405).



The Florida Department of Economic Opportunity submitted an application requesting \$5,000,000 in Disaster Recovery National Dislocated Worker Grant (DWG) funding. The purpose of the proposed project is to create disaster relief employment for eligible individuals to assist with cleanup activities in response to Hurricane Michael.



The funding will allow the State to begin the creation of disaster relief employment for approximately 250 eligible individuals to assist with cleanup efforts in 35 counties affected by Hurricane Michael.
