

Qualifying Events

Severe winter weather and freezing conditions beginning on February 15, 2021, caused significant damage throughout much of Texas. Water line breaks damaged buildings and affected roadways, creating unsafe conditions and limiting traffic. Rolling blackouts caused damage to power transmission stations, water utilities, and other important infrastructure. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) subsequently issued and twice-amended, in February 2021, a major disaster declaration under Texas; Major Disaster and Related Determinations (DR-4586).

Proposal Summary

The proposed funds will provide disaster-relief employment, along with employment and training services, to eligible individuals to assist with cleanup and recovery activities in response to the February 2021 severe winter storms in Texas. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) subsequently issued and twice-amended, in February 2021, a major disaster declaration under Texas; Major Disaster and Related Determinations (DR-4586).

Project Description

Texas' request for funding will help to create disaster-relief employment including debris and damage cleanup resulting from the storm and humanitarian assistance to connect economically disasdvantaged individuals with repair, maintenance, and other services. Funding will also provide employment and training services to individuals enrolled in the project.
