DETERMINATION

Determination of a Complaint Filed under Title IV of the Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959

On February 19, 2019, the Secretary of Labor received a complaint alleging violations of Section 401 of the Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959 (LMRDA), in the regularly scheduled election of officers conducted on December 5, 2018, by Machinists Local Lodge 701 in Carol Stream, Illinois.

Pursuant to Sections 402 and 601 of the LMRDA, the Department of Labor conducted an investigation. The investigation disclosed that Local Lodge 701 failed to provide a reasonable opportunity to nominate when it refused to allow a candidate who had submitted a written, blanket acceptance to decline nomination because he was not present at the nominations meeting. The investigation found that the candidate was unable to attend the nominations meeting because he was working.

Apprised of these findings, Machinists Local Lodge 701 agreed to conduct new nominations and a new election of officers under the supervision of the Secretary of Labor, in accordance with Title IV of the LMRDA. The agreed upon remedial election was concluded on July 10, 2019. It is, therefore,

<u>DETERMINED</u>, that there is probable cause to believe that violations of Title IV of the LMRDA occurred which may have affected the outcome of the election conducted by Machinists Local Lodge 701 on December 5, 2018, but that these violations have been remedied by the new election, conducted in accordance with Title IV of the LMRDA, under the supervision of the Secretary of Labor, on July 10, 2019.

Therefore, civil action under Section 402(b) of the LMRDA to set aside the election conducted on December 5, 2018 is not warranted.
