Employer and its Carrier (Employer) have filed a timely motion for reconsideration of the Benefits Review Board’s Decision and Order in *Hamlin v. Old Ben Coal Co.*, BRB No. 20-0547 BLA (Dec. 29, 2021) (unpub.), affirming the ALJ’s award of benefits. 33 U.S.C. §921(b)(5); 20 C.F.R. §802.407(a). The Director, Office of Workers’ Compensation Programs, opposes Employer’s motion. Claimant has not filed a response.

After consideration of Employer’s contentions and review of the Board’s disposition of this case, no member of the panel voted to grant reconsideration. Therefore, Employer’s motion for reconsideration is denied. 20 C.F.R. §§801.301(c), 802.409.
