Per guidance from the Federal Transition Coordinator, the Department of Labor (DOL) has identified the top operational items a new administration will have to handle immediately after Inauguration.

1. Coronavirus - 19 (COVID) Response

- Departmental position on necessary Pandemic Supplemental bills, including being prepared for short-turnaround Congressional technical assistance requests.
- Job Corps' centers operating posture or planned changes to that posture.
- Enforcement Agencies' Pandemic-related approach.
