## BTMed provides free medical exams for former DOE construction trades/subcontractor workers.









#### **Medical Screening Program**

- 2,405 exams → BTMed has performed 46,415 total exams
  -1,333 initial exams
  across 35 DOE sites
  - 1,072 rescreen exams

#### **ELCD (Early Lung Cancer Detection) Program**

• 348 CT Scans administered to 75 participants
