DEEOIC Claims Process – The Big Picture

- Three phases:
 - 1. ECS RED PANE review
 - 2. Case Development and Recommended Decision (RD)
 - 3. Hearings and Final Decisions (FD)
- Overall process flow

The Energy Employees Occupational Illness Compensation Program

Steps Conducted by CE

- Develop for medical conditions, employment, and survivorship (all RECA claims are handled in Denver DO)
- Use OHQ, SEM search, DAR, CMC referrals, IH referrals and/or Toxicology referrals to determine exposure & causation for Part E claims
- Issue RD to deny or accept
- Forward case file to FAB for review

The Energy Employees Occupational Illness Compensation Program

FAB & Hearings Process

- Conducts full case file review including the RD
- If the evidence supports the RD's conclusion, FAB waits for one of following from claimant:
 - Waiver (when RD is an acceptance)
 - Further information and/or objections
 - Request in writing for a hearing

The Energy Employees Occupational Illness Compensation Program

FAB Reviews Entire Case File

- FD provides an independent review of case file
- FD will either:
 - Agree with RD and issue FD with same conclusions
 - Disagree with RD and remand back to DO
 - Reverse RD and issue FD which differs from RD

The Energy Employees Occupational Illness Compensation Program

Claimants Rights After FD

- Claimant rights after FD issued:
 - Reconsideration
 - Reopening (if new evidence, new SEC class or change in NIOSH procedures)
 - Federal District Court
- No appeal from a remand claimant waits for new RD consistent with remand

Summary

- Three phases of the claims process:
 - 1. Red pane review
 - 2. DO development & RD
 - 3. Hearings & FD
- CE is responsible for red pane review, development of claim and issuance of RD

The Energy Employees Occupational Illness Compensation Program

Summary, continued

- FAB conducts case review and issues FD
- FD may or may not concur with RD
- Data accuracy is of paramount importance
