We will need a little time to put together Exposure for the Piketon, Ohio Workers for TCE and PCB's.

We are aware of the documents the local union submitted to the program on behalf of sick and dying workers from the Portsmouth Gaseous Diffusion Plant in Piketon, Ohio.

We have information that the PCB oil in all the processed buildings at the Portsmouth Gaseous Diffusion plant was radioactive. Senator Glenn held Congressional hearings about this oil.

We also have records of workers at the Portsmouth site that were given a special blood test for PCB's. I do have the list of workers and the results of the blood work.

Many workers tested high for the PCB's. We used TCE by the buckets with no protection because the DOE/DOD/Goodyear Atomic never informed the workers of the danger.

We also have records about the Plutonium and Transuranic elements on site.

We will get back with you soon with documents.

We are sending you another invitation to hold your meeting here in Portsmouth, Ohio, hopefully after the Savanna River meeting. We have asked many times.

Portsmouth/Paducah are the sites that compelled lawmakers to establish the EEOICPA because of unreported Plutonium exposure. We also have another overlooked hazards Fluorides which is our main chemical that isn't being discussed with this board.
