Under the EEOICP, the legal definition of Toxic substance is any material that has the potential because of the radio logical nature, or chemical nature, or biological nature. Based on the definition that cannot be changed, radiation is a toxic substance. The regulations also allow the claimant the right to address illnesses that were denied under Part B because of the radiation PoC, to be file with radiation and a toxic substance.

Illnesses listed in the SEM will not be diagnosed by a physician such as "solvent, acute", "metal fume fever", "chromium chronic toxic effect", etc. check SEM's list.

Need to add heavy metal toxicity, it was in the beginning but during a telephone conference Heavy metal toxicity was deleted.
